**Project Description:**

The new single-span two-lane Como Creek Bridge structure provides a permanent access route with pedestrian accommodation into the local commercial/retail area.

Just to the west of Schoolhouse Street, this structure was also used as a primary detour route during the construction of the Port Mann Bridge Project's King Edward Overpass.

**Corporate Role:**

Working as a subcontractor to the PMH1 Project Contractor, Coquitlam Ridge provided complete Design-Build services for the replacement of the existing temporary ACROW bridge.

The new structure consists of a pile-founded, single-span, cast-in-place concrete bridge with pre-stressed precast concrete box beams.

Reconstruction of the approaches, paving, and restoration of the site were also part of the contract.
